

WHAT DOCUMENTS YOU NEED TO BRING ON THE DAY OF YOUR ROAD TEST

If you are under 18, you must bring:

- Level I Learner's License (must be issued for at least 6 months or 180 days)
- Segment II Certificate of Completion
- Current registration for your vehicle
- Current proof of insurance for your vehicle
- Parent or guardian must accompany teens during their test. No one else is permitted in the vehicle, this includes children.

If you are over 18 and do not have a license from a different country, you must bring:

- Temporary Instruction Permit (TIP) (must be issued for at least 30 days or say "Waive 30 Days")
 - Current registration for your vehicle
 - Current proof of insurance for your vehicle
- *No one else is permitted in the vehicle besides the person taking the road test and the examiner unless an interpreter is needed. The interpreter must be provided by the customer.*

If you are over 18 and have a license from a different country, you must bring:

- White Receipt
 - Home country license
 - Current registration for your vehicle
 - Current proof of insurance for your vehicle
- *No one else is permitted in the vehicle besides the person taking the road test and the examiner unless an interpreter is needed. The interpreter must be provided by the customer.*

All customers have to bring their payment on the day of the road test. Cash or money order will only be accepted.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

You must make sure to do the following in order to avoid a \$25 fee.

- 1) Cancel or reschedule your appointment at least 24 hours in advance during our business hours. If your appointment is on a Monday, you must cancel the prior Saturday by noon.
- 2) Arrive on time.
- 3) Provide all necessary documentation listed above.
- 4) If you are under 18, you must bring a parent or legal guardian and no one else.
- 5) If you are over 18, no one else is able to come with you unless you need an interpreter.
- 6) Your vehicle must be road worthy and pass the vehicle inspection.

VEHICLE INSPECTION

The following equipment cannot be damaged, inoperative, or missing in order to take a road skills test: brakes, exhaust system (muffler), horn, lights (head lights, tail lights, brake lights, center-mounted rear brake light if applicable and turn signals), lug nuts, mirrors (rearview and outside left), safety belts and seats for all occupants, speedometer, springs, tires, wipers/washer fluid, windshield cannot be cracked or damaged, all driver and passenger doors must open from inside and outside.

If you do not have a road worthy vehicle we do provide rentals for an additional charge of \$35 at our Rochester and Waterford locations.
