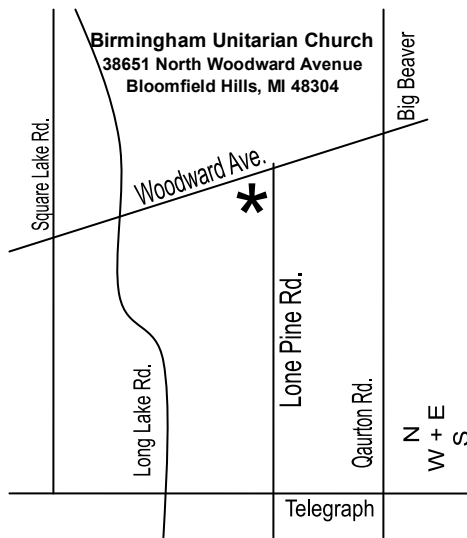

BRING WITH YOU TO THE ROAD TEST SITE:
 ___ Level I Learner's License (must be issued for at least 6 full months or 180 days)
 ___ Segment II Certificate of Completion
 ___ Current registration for your vehicle
 ___ Current proof of insurance for your vehicle
 A parent or legal guardian must accompany teens during their test. No one else is permitted in the vehicle, this includes children and pets.

ADULTS

BRING WITH YOU TO THE ROAD TEST SITE:
 ___ Temporary Instruction Permit (TIP) (must be issued for at least 30 days or say "Waive 30 Days")
 ___ White Receipt and home country license
 ___ Current registration for your vehicle
 ___ Current proof of insurance for your vehicle
 No one else is permitted in the vehicle, including children. If an interpreter is needed, this must be provided by the customer.
 Bring this confirmation card to your road test.

The cost for a Michigan Department of State Automobile Road Skills Test by Courtesy Driving School is **\$45 CASH or MONEY ORDER weekdays/\$50 Saturdays/\$55 Sundays** payable at the testing site. Your credit card is only used to reserve your appointment. There are no refunds due to failure of the road skills test. In the event of failure, you may retake the road skills test after 24 hours for a retest fee of \$30 (\$40 Sundays).

Cancellation of a road skills test must be done at least 24 hours in advance to avoid a \$25 cancellation fee. Cancellations for SUNDAY and MONDAY road skills tests must be done by the prior Saturday by noon.

Failure to arrive ON TIME, failure to provide necessary documentation, or failure of vehicle inspection for your road skills test will result in a \$25 fee (payable at the testing site).

Vehicle Inspection: The following equipment cannot be damaged, inoperative, or missing in order to take a road skills test: brakes, exhaust system (muffler), horn, lights (head lights, tail lights, brake lights, center-mounted rear brake light if applicable, turn signals), lug nuts (cannot be missing or broken), mirrors (rearview and outside left), safety belts and seats for all occupants, speedometer, springs, tires, wipers/washer fluid, windshield cannot be cracked or damaged, all driver and passenger doors must open from inside and outside.

Rental automobiles available upon request for an additional fee of \$35 when specified at the time the appointment is scheduled.
