

DOCUMENTS YOU NEED TO BRING ON THE DAY OF YOUR ROAD TEST

Teens under 18 years of age must bring:

- Level I Learner's License (must be issued for at least 180 days)
- Segment II Certificate of Completion
- Current proof of registration for your vehicle
- Current proof of insurance for your vehicle
- A parent or legal guardian must accompany teens during their test. No one else is permitted in the vehicle, this includes children and pets.

Adults 18 years of age or older with a Temporary Instruction Permit (TIP) must bring:

- Temporary Instruction Permit (TIP) (must be issued for at least 30 days or say "Waive 30 Days")
- Current proof of registration for your vehicle
- Current proof of insurance for your vehicle

You must be accompanied to the test site by a properly-licensed adult; however, no one else is permitted in the vehicle during the test other than the person taking the test and the road test examiner. If an interpreter is needed, this must be provided by the customer.

Adults 18 years of age or older with a White Receipt (.01¢ Receipt) must bring:

- White Receipt
- Home country license
- Current proof of registration for your vehicle
- Current proof of insurance for your vehicle

You must be accompanied to the test site by a properly-licensed adult; however, no one else is permitted in the vehicle during the test other than the person taking the test and the road test examiner. If an interpreter is needed, this must be provided by the customer.

Payment in the form of CASH or MONEY ORDER only is required at the time of the road test.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

In order to avoid a \$25.00 fee, you must:

1. Cancel or reschedule your appointment at least 24 hours in advance during Courtesy Driving School business hours (you must speak to an office representative to cancel or reschedule your appointment). Cancellations for SUNDAY or MONDAY road tests must be done by the prior Saturday by noon.
2. Bring payment in the form of CASH or MONEY ORDER only to the test site.
3. Arrive on time (please arrive at least 10 minutes prior to your appointment time).
4. Provide all necessary documentation listed above.
5. Bring a road-worthy vehicle, one that will pass the vehicle inspection listed below.
6. If you are under 18 years of age, you must be accompanied to the test by a parent or legal guardian (no one else is permitted in the vehicle, this includes children and pets).
7. If you are 18 years of age or older, you must be accompanied to the test by a properly-licensed adult; however, no one else is permitted in the vehicle during the test other than the person taking the test and the road test examiner. If an interpreter is needed, this must be provided by the customer.

VEHICLE INSPECTION

The following equipment cannot be damaged, inoperative, or missing in order to take a road skills test: brakes, exhaust system (muffler), horn, lights (head lights, tail lights, brake lights, center-mounted rear brake light if applicable, and turn signals), lug nuts (cannot be missing or broken), mirrors (rearview and outside left), safety belts and seats for all occupants, speedometer, springs, tires, wipers/washer fluid, windshield cannot be cracked or damaged, and all driver and passenger doors must open from the inside and the outside.

If you do not have a road-worthy vehicle, we provide rentals for an additional charge of \$35.00 at our Rochester and Waterford test sites.
