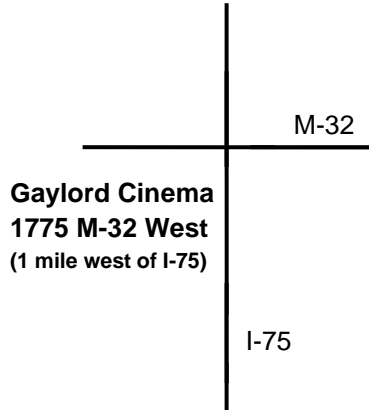

Motorcycle Tests

TEENS

BRING THE FOLLOWING LEGIBLE ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS:

- ___ Level I Learner's License (must be issued for at least 6 full months)
 - ___ Segment II Certificate of Completion
 - ___ Driving Log (50 Hours, 10 Hours Night Driving)
 - ___ Current registration for your vehicle
 - ___ Current certificate of insurance for your vehicle
- A parent (or legal guardian with court papers) must accompany teens during their test. No one else is permitted in the vehicle, this includes children & pets.

The cost for a road skills test by Courtesy Driving School is **\$60 payable with credit/debit card at the time of scheduling. There are no refunds due to failure of the road skills test.** In the event of failure, you may retake the road skills test after 24 hours for a retest fee of \$40.

Cancellation or change of a road skills test must be made at least 72 hours prior to the test, in order to avoid a \$25 fee. Failure to arrive on time to your test will result in a \$25 fee and no test.

Failure of the document or vehicle inspections will result in a \$30 fee and no test.

ADULTS

BRING THE FOLLOWING LEGIBLE ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS:

- ___ Temporary Instruction Permit (TIP) (must be issued for at least 30 days or say "Waive 30 Days")
 - ___ DSTAR and home country license
 - ___ Current registration for your vehicle
 - ___ Current certificate of insurance for your vehicle
- Only adult and examiner allowed in car during test, no one else is permitted. If an interpreter is needed, this must be provided by the customer.

Vehicle Inspection: The following equipment cannot be damaged, inoperative, or missing in order to take a road skills test: brakes, exhaust system (muffler), horn, **ALL LIGHTS MUST WORK** (head lights, tail lights, brake lights, center-mounted rear brake light, turn signals), lug nuts, mirrors (rearview, outside left & right), safety belts and seats for all occupants, speedometer, springs, tires, wipers/washer fluid, windshield cannot be cracked or damaged, all driver and passenger doors must open from inside and outside. **If applicant is a MINOR, vehicle must have back seat.**

Applicant must wear closed-toe shoes during test.
