

DOCUMENTS YOU NEED TO BRING ON THE DAY OF YOUR ROAD TEST

Teens under 18 years of age must bring the following original hard copy format documents:

- Level I Learner's License (must be issued for at least 6 months)
 - Segment II Certificate of Completion
 - Driving Log documenting at least 50 hours of supervised driving, including a minimum of 10 hours at night
 - Current registration for your vehicle
 - Current certificate of insurance for your vehicle
- A parent or legal guardian must accompany teens during their test. No one else is permitted in the vehicle, this includes children and pets.

Adults 18 years of age or older with a Temporary Instruction Permit (TIP) must bring the following original hard copy format documents:

- Temporary Instruction Permit (TIP) (must be issued for at least one month unless "waived")
- Current registration for your vehicle
- Current certificate of insurance for your vehicle

You must be accompanied to the test site by a properly-licensed adult; however, no one else is permitted in the vehicle during the test other than the person taking the test and the road test examiner. If an interpreter is needed, this must be provided by the customer.

Adults 18 years of age or older with a DSTAR (Driving Skills Test Authorization Receipt) must bring the following original hard copy format documents:

- DSTAR document
- Home country license
- Current registration for your vehicle
- Current certificate of insurance for your vehicle

You must be accompanied to the test site by a properly-licensed adult; however, no one else is permitted in the vehicle during the test other than the person taking the test and the road test examiner. If an interpreter is needed, this must be provided by the customer.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

In order to avoid a **\$25.00 fee**, you must:

1. Cancel or reschedule your appointment at least 72 hours prior to the scheduled appointment time.
2. Arrive on time (please arrive at least 10 minutes prior to your appointment time).
3. Provide all necessary documentation listed above.
4. Bring a road-worthy vehicle, one that will pass the vehicle inspection listed below.
5. If you are under 18 years of age, you must be accompanied to the test by a parent or legal guardian (no one else is permitted in the vehicle, this includes children and pets).
6. If you are 18 years of age or older, you must be accompanied to the test by a properly-licensed adult; however, no one else is permitted in the vehicle during the test other than the person taking the test and the road test examiner. If an interpreter is needed, this must be provided by the customer.
7. Applicant must wear closed-toe shoes during test.

VEHICLE INSPECTION

The following equipment cannot be damaged, inoperative, or missing in order to take a road skills test: brakes, exhaust system (muffler), horn, lights (head lights, tail lights, brake lights, center-mounted rear brake light if applicable, and turn signals), lug nuts (cannot be missing or broken), mirrors (rearview and outside left), safety belts and seats for all occupants, speedometer, springs, tires, wipers/washer fluid, windshield cannot be cracked or damaged, and all driver and passenger doors must open from the inside and the outside. If the vehicle does not pass inspection, there will be a thirty dollar (\$30.00) charge.
